Why this operating gap persists

- Signals arrive through systems that do not know the company-specific operating consequence.
- Enterprise context remains split across sites, suppliers, routes, products, commitments, contracts and decision rights.
- Response options compete for the same budget, capacity, timing and authority.
- The record of what was known and authorized is rarely preserved through execution and review.

Three reinforcing defensibility layers

Layer	Asset	How value accumulates
Ready on day one	Prepared disruption operating model	Hazard-specific evidence, canonical decision objects, action classes, constraints and authority patterns
Specialized through use	Customer-specific decision system	Verified dependencies, commitments, feasibility knowledge, approvals, execution and outcomes
Governed reusable structure	Rights-authorized de-identified patterns	Reviewed methods can improve without transferring customer records

What is inspectable now

- A historical disruption and illustrative enterprise model carried through the full management lifecycle.
- Hazard evidence and an enterprise dependency path with distinct evidence classes.
- Deterministic in-browser comparison of all 32 portfolios in a five-action set.
- Visible constraints, rejected alternatives, authorization states and a session-local decision history.
- A public method statement that names both the formulation and the open validation questions.
